

## IV. ORGANIZATIONS

### 1. UNITED METHODIST MEN

- a. Purpose: Refer to *The Book of Discipline of The United Methodist Church-1996*, Par. 664. United Methodist Men shall be a creative supportive fellowship of men who seek to know Jesus Christ, to grow spiritually, and to seek daily God's will. Its primary purpose is to declare the centrality of Christ in the lives of men and in all their relationships
- b. Membership — All members of local units of United Methodist Men within the Conference
- c. Officers elected for the quadrennium
  - (1) President
  - (2) Two Vice Presidents
  - (3) Secretary
  - (4) Treasurer shall be the Conference Treasurer/Comptroller (non-voting)
- d. Conference Committee
  - (1) Officers
  - (2) Conference Lay Leader
  - (3) Conference Prayer Advocate
  - (4) Conference Scouting Coordinator
  - (5) Immediate Past President
  - (6) District Presidents of United Methodist Men (9)
  - (7) Resident Bishop

- f. Sub-Committees and Task Forces  
The Conference Committee may establish sub-committees and/or task forces defining their duties and authority in order to fulfill its purpose, provided that these sub-committees and/or task forces shall have had prior approval by the CCOM Executive Committee and not extend beyond a period of one year without explicitly approved for one-year extensions if deemed necessary
